While playing games in cooperative groups, students strengthen their strategic thinking and critical reasoning abilities.

Integration of spatial, computational and logical reasoning are key parts of Math Pentathlon. Hudsonville Christian has 80+ students participate in the math pentathlon program each year.

Parents who volunteer to help every Tuesday receive a discounted rate when they register their kids. Training is required for all volunteers.
